The students have 45 days to design and create a robot for district competition. Last season, the program won the "Excellence in Engineering Award" in which 40 teams were in the running. The robotics team is led by Metz Middle School teacher, Arlene Higgins, "The team gives students hands on experience needed to give them an edge in their fields of study. They learned a variety of skills and how to communicate with each other," said Higgins.
